Blind Boys of Alabama

The Blind Boys of Alabama have the rare distinction of being recognized around the world as both living legends and modern-day innovators. They are not just gospel singers borrowing from old traditions; the group helped to define those traditions in the 20th century and almost single-handedly created a new gospel sound for the 21st. Since the original members first sang together as kids at the Alabama Institute for the Negro Blind in the late 1930s, the band has persevered through seven decades to become one of the most recognized and decorated roots music groups in the world. Celebrated by both The Grammy® Foundation and The National Endowment for the Arts with Lifetime Achievement Awards, inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame and winners of five Grammy® Awards, they have attained the highest levels of recognition. The Blind Boys have been hailed as “gospel titans” by Rolling Stone, and they have collaborated with everyone from Mavis Staples and Stevie Wonder to Prince and Lou Reed.

At this performance, they will be joined by special guest Charlie Musselwhite, who more than any other harmonica player of his generation can rightfully lay claim to inheriting the mantle of many of the great harp players who came before him with music as dark as Mississippi mud and as uplifting as the blue skies of California. In an era when the term legendary gets applied to auto-tuned pop stars, this singular blues harp player, singer, songwriter and guitarist has earned and deserves to be honored as a true master of American classic vernacular music.


Carnaval!

When not on tour with Santana, Lindsay performs at various local venues and festivals—having become a regular performer for The Golden State Warriors, The San Francisco 49ers, The San Francisco Giants and The San Jose Sharks, singing the national anthem.

Named an official “Cultural Ambassador to the National Identity of Argentina,” and on the tail of numerous successes including events and performances in Las Vegas, New York, Dubai, Paris, Cairo, St. Petersburg and Montreal as well as special performances with Latin pop-star Ricky Martin, Cirque du Soleil, a yearlong residency at Universal Studios Japan and making it to semifinalists on the hit TV show “America’s Got Talent,” Malevo is excited to present their new high-energy percussive touring performance.



Sons of Mystro

Sons of Mystro is the violin duo of two brothers, Malcolm and Umoja, who play more than 10 different genres of popular music using violin instead of voice. They have been mentored by the groundbreaking group Black Violin, and they use their violins to interpret reggae classics, American pop songs and their own creations accompanied by a DJ and a drummer. Their approach to music brought them recognition as Emerging Artists under 21 Years Old at the International Reggae and World Music Awards and since forming in June 2010, Sons of Mystro has performed at a variety of events including ESPN/BCS Championship party, opening for The Fray, the 8th Annual Jazz in The Gardens, and alongside R&B Band Jazz acts such as Najee, Fantasia, Kenny “Babyface” Edmonds, Charlie Wilson, New Edition and Earth Wind and Fire.

Mariachi Los Camperos

Three-time Grammy® winner Mariachi Los Camperos presents "Viva Mexico!" Mariachi Los Camperos was founded in 1961 by Natividad "Nati" Cano and has played a fundamental role in the development of mariachi music in the United States by mentoring new generations of musicians and expanding audiences. A visionary leader, Cano's goal was to take mariachi beyond cantinas and onto the stages of the biggest and best concert halls. Today, under the leadership of longtime musical director Jesus "Chuy" Guzman, this groundbreaking mariachi ensemble continues to realize that vision and remains a beacon of artistic excellence and deep community engagement. Join us on a journey through the many states of Mexico and experience the array of colorful traditional songs with dances performed by Grupo Folclorico Chiquina Palafox.



Tommy Castro & The Painkillers



Whether he's squeezing out the deepest blues or playing the funkier soul grooves, legendary blues and soul giant Tommy Castro knows how to ignite a crowd. Over the course of his still-unfolding career, the guitarist, vocalist and songwriter has released 15 albums ranging from horn-fueled soul and R&B to piping hot blues to fiery rock n' roll. He's performed all over the world, earning countless fans with his legendary, sweat-drenched, exhilarating live shows.

For Castro's new album, a roots music odyssey entitled "Tommy Castro Presents A Bluesman Came To Town," he tells a timeless story. This special project was composed by Castro along with Grammy® Award-winning producer Tom Hambridge. Through its 13 songs, this album tells the tale of a young man working on his family farm who gets bitten by the blues bug. He masters the guitar and heads out on the road seeking fame and fortune, only to find what he's left behind is the treasure he's been looking for.





ZAKIR HUSSAIN

Zakir Hussain & Masters of Percussion

Every other year since 1996, Zakir Hussain has served as curator, conductor and producer to bring the very cream of Indian music and world percussion to tour America and Europe with his series, Zakir Hussain and Masters of Percussion.

Growing out of his renowned international tabla duet tours with his father, the legendary Ustad Allarakha, Masters of Percussion began as a platform for both popular and rarely heard rhythm traditions from India. While performing and collaborating in India for a few months every year, Zakir has sought and unearthed lesser-known folk and classical traditions which feed into the greater stream of Indian music, playing an educational role in affording them greater visibility, as well as introducing them to audiences in the West. Over time, the constantly changing ensemble has expanded to include great drummers and percussionists from many world traditions, including jazz. All of it creates a truly beautiful field from which he can bring Masters of Percussion to the West. The 2023 version will once again present American audiences with extraordinary, exciting and spontaneous combinations of percussive as well as melodic performances.

Past years have included master drummers from Central Asia, India and the U.S., virtuosi like Abbos Kosimov, a master of the Uzbek frame drum known as the doyra, Marcus Gilmore, the most talked about young jazz drummer of our time, Eric Harland of Sangam and Niladri Kumar, the great young sitarist. They play individually and together, and the results are unforgettable; 2023 will be no exception!



The Queen's Cartoonists

March 18, 2023 at 8:00 PM

Currently hailing from Queens, New York, The Queen's Cartoonists bring iconic cartoons to life. Pulling from more than 100 years of animation, their performances are perfectly synchronized to the films projected on stage. Hailed by the Los Angeles Times as "a visual and aural treat," the band matches the energy of the animations, leading the audience through a world of virtuosic musicianship, multi-instrumental mayhem and madcap comedy.

Watch your favorite classic cartoon characters interact with the musicians on stage, and expect the unexpected from the Golden Age of Animation, cult cartoon classics and modern animated films. Inspired by the crossroads of jazz, classical music and cartoons, the show features Jazz Age composers like Carl Stalling, Raymond Scott and Duke Ellington, alongside classical giants Mozart, Rossini and R. Strauss (to name just a few).

The Queen's Cartoonists have opened for the New York Philharmonic and are the only artist in the 40-plus year history of the Blue Note Jazz Club in New York City to sell out multiple all-ages shows.
