



Loading Door

Accessible from Jackson Alley off of Central Street. Loading and unloading only, long term parking nearby. Please advance load-in needs with Cultural Arts Technical Supervisor.

Loading door level with ground. 10'h x 8'w (directly onto stage).

No ramp or fork-lift on site. If required please notify in advance.

Tour Bus/Truck Parking

Tour Bus Parking may available on Jackson Alley or 7th Street. Please Note: 7th street has a significant crown for water drainage. If the bus does not have adequate leveling it might be hard to use the bus.

Street closure is possible to allow for up to four busses or to allow for two busses to park flat in the center. Closeable portion of alley is 290' long by 15'-4" wide.

Unless a permit has been obtained trucks, after unloading, must be moved. Parking for smaller trucks can be reserved on 7th street. Semi parking is available in a lot just south of downtown.


ALL Bus/Truck parking must be pre-approved by Cultural Arts Technical Supervisor.

Orchestra Pit

11'-8" deep x 42'-10" wide x 9'-7" high (removable 3'-0" deep x 8'-0" wide sections)

Adjustable depth via manual removal of staging sections and scaffolding (extra staffing required)

Access by SL and SR stairs Pit extends under stage 3'-6" 25 person occupancy



Dressing Rooms

16' x 18' each

2 – 7 stations, 2 sinks, 1 toilet and shower, 1 wardrobe rack, 1 steamer, 1 iron and 1 ironing board.

Backstage

Crossover via upstage directly behind cyclorama or under stage (stair access only). Dressing and Green Rooms accessible via backstage.

Backstage areas have stage audio and video monitors.

Green room

22' x 29'

Please verify room's availability in the advance. Phone available upon request in the advance (209.831.6284). Tables and chairs. Wireless internet available. The only restrooms backstage are in the 2 dressing rooms.


Below stage

15' x 30' x 7'h

Area can be used as costume/prop area or as additional performer space. There are no restrooms and it is stair access only (unless orchestra pit is in use, if pit is not filled there is a handicap elevator lift). Sometimes used as theatre storage, please check with Cultural Arts Technical Supervisor.

Storage space is extremely limited in our facility please arrange with the Cultural Arts Technical Supervisor if you need to store unused or empty road cases.

No Washer/Dryer or Sewing Machine on site.






